David is a graduate of Midwestern Baptist College (1987) and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School (1996). He also did doctoral work at Trinity. David combines a passion for the in-depth study of Scripture with a shepherd's heart.

David and Helen have been married for twenty-three years. They have three sons. Andrew (21); Nate (19); and Michael (13). The Jones family gives glory to God for His guidance, provision and protection through the years.
